DEADLINE TO REGISTER WEDNESDAY

Greene County Clerk Richard Struckhoff reminds residents they have until this Wednesday, Jan. 11, to become registered for the Feb. 7 Presidential Preference Primary Election.

“Those who are not registered may apply at any one of our many permanent voter registration locations, including schools, libraries, colleges, city halls and the Historic Courthouse,” Struckhoff said. Mail-in (postcard) registrations will also be accepted if postmarked by Jan. 11.

The Feb. 7 ballot features partisan ballots for Democratic, Republican, Libertarian and Constitution Party supporters, as well as local issues for voters in the cities of Springfield, Republic and Willard. Sample ballots may be viewed on the Clerk’s website:
