## **DEADLINE TO REGISTER WEDNESDAY**

Greene County Clerk Richard Struckhoff reminded residents Wednesday, March 9, is the deadline to become registered for the April 5 Election.

“Those who are not registered can apply at any one of our many permanent voter registration locations, including schools, libraries, colleges, city hall, and the courthouse,” Struckhoff said. Mail-in (postcard) registrations will also be accepted if they are postmarked by Wednesday.

In Greene County, the April Election involves nine cities, nine school districts and three fire protection districts. Springfield voters will consider candidates for Mayor and City Council, along with two issues.

Voter registration only takes about three minutes to complete. Be sure to bring along a driver’s license or other acceptable identification. Under state and federal laws, voters are not disenfranchised for changing their residence within a county without revising their voter registration, but Struckhoff urges anyone who has moved or changed their name to contact his office as soon as possible to avoid unnecessary delays on election day.
