### Cindy/Laura,

I've gathered some additional information from our Shop Supervisor, Lazall, to help us make a decision.

Our existing loader is a 2005 924G, and originally cost \$104,314.00.

Its estimated value today is around the \$20,000-\$40,000 range without an actual appraisal.

A new machine of comparable size like an Cat 930 wheel loader is around \$220,000.

If we were to replace the cab via this quote, it is estimated that our existing loader might last us another 5-10 years, or it could quit tomorrow (5-10 years is our best guess).

All things considered, especially with the inflation in the economy right now (and delays on receiving new equipment), we feel we'd be time & money ahead to replace the cab now.

It's a cost-efficient repair that would provide us with a machine to use now, safely, and hopefully will last us 5-10 more years.

Would this constitute an emergency purchase request?

Again, with the state of the economy right now, increased prices and equipment delays, we would like to procure this used cab so we can keep our operations running and not have to spend \$220,000 on a new machine.
