9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting October 16, 2019

- CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Williams on October 16, 2019 at 3:01 p.m. in the Public Safety Center, 9-1-1 Conference room at 330 W. Scott Street, Springfield, MO 65802. Seven board members and proxies were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL September 18, 2019 Meeting Minutes Williams indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Pennington motioned to approve the minutes, Wade seconded. Motion carried 7/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - Financial Reports - Mike Cagle, representing the Greene County Budget Office, presented the August Financial reports. August represents 67% of the year. August Sales Tax Receipts came in very strong. Revenues are currently ahead of pace. Overall expenditures were 63% of budget. Personnel expenditures were 60% of budget leaving a vacancy on pace to \$654,439.13. This is well over the budgeted vacancy of \$276,000. Actual operations were 83% of budget. This is ahead of pace due to CAD Maintenance, Professional Services, and Office Supplies. Capital, Debt Service & Contingency were 1.8% of budget. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen Liab, Tele, Spfd All OvrHd, CAD Sys Maint) expenses are 60.9% of budget. With contingency removed Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$4,091,523 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$3,630,473 for a \$461,050 volume to the good. Cash balance at 8/31/19 consisted of the \$300,000.00 equipment reserve and \$3,927,445 in the warrant account. This is \$844,296 higher than last year. Uncleared checks at month-end totaled 336,504. This leaves a net cash value of \$3,890,941. Net cash level is 2.61 times larger than required operating reserve level of \$1,490,156. The outstanding items is 99.9% Springfield's July billing.

- A. Emergency Communications Department Update Schwartze The September monthly "Atta's" and compliments were passed around. There were no external complaints during the month of September. Schwartze noted the Emergency Communications department is working on implementing Guardian Tracking software for the entire department to assist with personnel files and electronic filing. She stated the CALEA accreditation process is on track and looking at the mock assessment to occur in January 2020.
- **B. P1CAD and Statistics Update –Webb–** The September and Year-to-Date 9-1-1 Reports were provided. Webb noted the Springfield-Greene County 9-1-1 call takers are currently at 88.5% calls answered in ten seconds and Text-to-911 calls are up by ten percent. He stated a CAD upgrade will be coming soon.
