**Voter Registration Deadline for August 2 Election –
Wednesday, July 6**

Greene County Clerk Shane Schoeller reminds all eligible Greene County residents that they have until 5:00 pm on Wednesday, July 6 to register to vote with eligibility for the General Primary Election on Tuesday, August 2. To register to vote, residents may visit the County Clerk's Office in the Historic Courthouse at 940 N. Boonville, Room 113 in Springfield or any branch of the Springfield-Greene County Library. Mail-in (postcard) registrations will also be accepted if postmarked by Wednesday, July 6. Registration is also available online at:

When registering to vote, be sure to have an acceptable form of identification, such as a valid driver's license, current utility bill or bank statement. Under state and federal laws, registered voters are not disqualified for moving within a county, but Schoeller urges anyone who has moved or changed his/her name to contact the County Clerk's Office as soon as possible to avoid unnecessary delays and help ensure a better voting experience on the day of the election. These changes must be completed in writing.

The August 2 election will list candidates for several county, state, and federal offices, as well as issues in the City of Republic and the Ash Grove Fire Protection District. Sample ballots for Greene County are available in the County Clerk's Office and online at:
