Additional Location Designated for No-Excuse Absentee Voting in April 2 General Municipal Election

Springfield, MO - Greene County Clerk Shane Schoeller announces to Greene County registered voters that beginning **Tuesday, March 26**, the Library Center at 4653 S. Campbell Ave. in Springfield will serve as an additional location for in-person absentee voting in the upcoming General Municipal Election on Tuesday, April 2. Under Missouri law, voters who vote in-person absentee within two weeks of an election may do so without having to give a reason.

In-person absentee voting will be available at the Library Center <u>Tuesday – Friday, March 26 – 29 and</u> <u>Monday, April 1</u>, between the hours of <u>9:00 am – 4:00 pm</u>. **Please note that in order to vote in-person absentee, by statute voters must present one of the following forms of photo identification:**

- A nonexpired Missouri driver or non-driver license;
- A nonexpired military ID, including a veteran's ID card;
- A nonexpired United States passport;
- Another photo ID issued by the United States or the state of Missouri which is either not expired or expired after the date of the most recent general election.

In-person absentee voting is also available at the Greene County Elections Center, 1126 N. Boonville Ave. in Springfield, Monday to Friday between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, up to and including the day prior to the election, and will also be available at the Elections Center on Saturday, March 30 from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm.
