

Great Game Huddle Notes

Deputy Budget Officer, Tina Phillips welcomed huddle participants. She introduced Commissioner Roseann Bentley for the monthly Commissioner Corner report. Commissioner Bentley mentioned that last month was the 25th anniversary of the Great Game of Business management technique. Jack Stack hosted a celebration at the Classic Rock Café in recognition of the anniversary and the Commission was honored to receive an invitation to attend.
