Interesting Facts:

- Attorneys in average 100-150 cases each.
- Turnover continues to be an issue.
- The PA Office provides approximately 40 hours of accredited training per year.
- All types of cases are on the rise.
- Many cases are served by summons instead of warrants.
- Felony cases are charge or release within 24 hours.
- The Discovery Unit is becoming the largest unit in the office.

Staff took huddle participants on a tour of the 2 floors. According to Stephanie Wan, the upside is more space and organized departments, the downside is not being located in the courthouse.
