Tagline: "Greene County Works...". This tagline represents our most important function – the county works. The ellipsis allows for a specific focus to be highlighted, which include "Greene County Works... to Serve You.", "Greene County Works... Hard.", "Greene County Works... Well Together.". The tagline will be highlighted on the Greene County website and will be used as a primary element in future public outreach initiatives.

Updated Website: The Greene County website has been updated with a contemporary design, easily identifiable headline categories, and a user-friendly search tool interface.
