Personal Property and Business Assessment list deadline March 1

Greene County Assessor Rick Kessinger reminds county residents that March 1 is the deadline for returning 2018 Individual and Business Personal Property Assessment lists to his office to avoid late filing penalties, which range from \$15 to \$105, depending on assessed value.

Any individual or business owning or controlling taxable tangible personal property as of January 1, 2018, including property purchased on that date, is required to declare all taxable individual and business personal property to the assessor (RSMo. 137.115). The property to declare includes, but is not limited to, motor vehicles, boats, trailers, livestock, farm machinery and business-related furniture and equipment. The assessment lists are the basis for 2018 individual and business property tax bills that the county collector mails to owners in November.

Any resident who moved into or out of Greene County in 2017 is advised to contact the Assessor's Office in both counties to ensure assessment in the proper county.
