


Missouri Revised Statute 311.220, the Missouri Liquor Control Law, grants counties the power to issue a liquor license in the amount therein limited, and to impose fees for late renewals in an amount of five [5] dollars per day, not to exceed the original amount of the license. An Order of the County Commission dated August 16, 2010 establishes such a licensing requirement in Greene County, Missouri, and the same imposes the above fees on every business in Greene County that possesses a Missouri Liquor License. The license granted by said County Commission may be revoked at any time, upon proper showing of any violation by any employee of the above-mentioned business entity, of any law of the State of Missouri or any regulation, ordinance, or rule of the city in which the above-mentioned business entity conducts business involving the sale of intoxicating liquor. Upon revocation the abovementioned business entity shall not be entitled to the refund in whole or in part of the fee paid for this license. Revised Statute 311.880 provides that a violation of the Missouri Liquor Control Law is a misdemeanor offence punishable by a fine of up to $\$ 1000.00$ and a country jail sentence of up to one year, or by both, except as otherwise provided in 311. The license issued hereunder shall not be effective until the above-mentioned business entity shall have applied for and been granted a license by the supervisor of Liquor Control for the State of Missouri.
