## **DISCUSSION**

Hot and humid conditions are expected across the area today as heat index values of 100 to 110 are expected. Southwesterly winds will gust up to 30 mph. A low chance for showers and storms late tonight is possible into Saturday morning. Hot conditions are again expected through the weekend and into next week. Possible thunderstorms across portions of the area next week.

## **CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT**

- Stay hydrated, stay in an air-conditioned room, limit time in the sun, and check on relatives and neighbors.
- Young children and pets should never be left unattended in vehicles under any circumstances.
- Take extra precautions if you work or spend time outside. When possible, reschedule strenuous activities to early morning or evening.
- To reduce risk during outdoor work, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration recommends scheduling frequent rest breaks in shaded or airconditioned environments.
- Know the signs and symptoms of heat exhaustion and heat stroke. Wear lightweight and loose-fitting clothing when possible. Anyone overcome by heat should be moved to a cool and shaded location. Heat stroke is an emergency! Call 9 1 1.
