DISCUSSION

Dangerous heat continues through the afternoon and early evening as heat index values reach 105 to 115 degrees. This extreme excessive heat risk will continue the Excessive Heat Warning through Friday. Much of the region will be impacted during the afternoon and evening hours through Friday. Cooler temperatures are expected this weekend and into next week. Continue to monitor the National Weather Service for changes in this time of dangerous heat.

CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT

- Have a severe weather shelter plan. Review your emergency kit and identify the closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area.
- "When thunder roars . . . go indoors!"
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels.

"Turn around . . . don't drown!"
