What regulations are violated most often?

Building

- Building without a permit
- Expired building permit
- Occupying without a Certificate of Occupancy





Environmental

- Surfacing or failed onsite wastewater system
- Illegal onsite wastewater system installation or repair
- Grading without a permit
- Blocking drainage way

Zoning

- High weeds and grass
- Trash and dumping
- Immobilized vehicles
- Living in an RV/Travel Trailer
- Animals
- Unauthorized business operation
- Dangerous or unsecured structure










Living in a travel trailer
