What are your requirements?

- 18 years or older
- Must have lived in our service area for at least 6 months if under 21
- Must be able to give a one-year commitment
- Must have valid drivers license, insurance, and transportation
- No drug or alcohol convictions within the last three years
- No hospitalization or treatment for substance related addiction in the past five years
- No pending felony or felony conviction
- No drug use or underage drinking
- Must demonstrate stable lifestyle, emotional maturity, and responsible judgement
