

## Juvenile Departments

#### Courts

 Facilitates the care, protection and discipline of children who come within the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court.


### Detention

 Is utilized when it is necessary to hold a child until a court hearing can be held or disposition made.

### Grants

- Division of Youth Services (DYS)
- Provides local community based services to adjudicated juveniles who have been on probation.

## GR Total 2016 Appropriations = 42,176,175 Juvenile is 10.57% of GR Budget



## Juvenile Salary Reimbursements

- Multi-County Judicial Circuit Courts
  - Second, Third, Fourth Class Counties
  - 100% employee cost reimbursed
- Greene County 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial Court (Single Circuit)
  - First Class County
  - Only 25% employee cost reimbursed
  - Frozen at 1997 salary base



## Did you know....


In 2015, Juvenile office salaries totaled \$2.75 million.

If Greene County were to receive 25% of the *current* salaries our present State reimbursement of \$288,000 *would increase* by \$400,394 to \$688,394.

As it stands, we are being reimbursed for only about 10.4% of current salaries instead of the 25% intended.

## **Salary Reimbursement**




## Juvenile Per Diem

Greene County's costs for each juvenile detainee run approx. \$90 per day.

Actual reimbursement is only \$14 per day.
