1. Resource Management—Kevin Barnes

- *Update on ASFPM (Association of State Flood Plain Managers) Conference Kevin attended in Grand Rapids, Michigan. The national conference will be in Kansas City, MO next year. They discussed insurance rates and the impact it has as a portion of the conference agenda.*
- *EDEN software has gone live and will make functions of the Resource Management Department more efficient with being able to access information on any particular property at the time of inspection.*
