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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Springfield-Greene County Office of Emergency Management hosted, in conjunction with the Emergency Operations Center Workshop, the annual Training and Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW) on November 2nd, 2017 at the Greene County Public Safety Center, 330 W. Scott Street, Springfield, MO 65802. The purpose of the workshop was to synchronize and coordinate training and exercise opportunities to prevent duplications of effort, collectively review current strategies and grant deliverables, and develop a plan to increase preparedness through training and exercises.

There were 46 participants at the Training and Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW) representing the various disciplines within the Springfield-Greene County community. The result of this workshop is a Springfield-Greene County Training and Exercise Plan for the years 2018-2021 and the validation of the Core Capabilities for 2018.

The workshop was devoted to a review of the following areas of interest and documents intended to identify/verify/validate and prioritize the disaster preparedness capabilities on which priority emphasis should be placed in the next three years: completion of Region D Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA), exercise corrective actions plans from all exercises conducted or participated in within the past two years, requirements/obligations included in all current preparedness grant requests/allocations, and any relevant local/regional program initiatives.

Conduct a systematic process engaging the whole community as appropriate in the development of executable strategic, operational and/or tactical level approaches to meet defined objectives.
