MINUTES

Daily Briefing

September 27, 2017

Greene County Commission Office

9:30 a.m.

Present: Harold Bengsch, Lincoln Hough, Chris Coulter, Trysta Herzog, Cindy Stein, Stephanie Hamilton, Jeff Scott and Kate Morris.

Stephanie Hamilton updated the Commission on Pretrial Services. She said they are currently supervising 207 cases; 20 of which involve GPS and four involving SCRAM monitoring. She said the majority of the cases they are supervising are Class C felonies. Currently there is an average of 456 days from the start of supervision to conviction. The staff recently lost one report writer. They'll be meeting with Judge Becky Borthwick soon to brief her on the program. She said Christian County recently reached out to them for information about their operation as they are considering starting up their own pretrial program.

A COMET vehicle lease agreement for the Sheriff's Office was presented to Commission. This agreement had been signed already, but a few changes were made regarding insurance so it was amended. (On file at County Clerk's Office.)

Commissioner Bengsch made the motion to approve the agreement. Commissioner Hough seconded the motion. The motion passed.
