

Greene County Commission Briefing

The Highway Safety Grant, which had been tabled twice before for lack of information, was revisited a third time. Phil Corcoran gave an overview of the grant benefits and noted that they would be removing the request for additional deputies. They would still ask for the following: \$50,000 for vehicle occupant protection, \$120,000 for MODOT HMV, \$75,000 on youth alcohol program, and DWI overtime coverage. Commissioner Cirtin made a motion to authorize the grant application. Commissioner Hough seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The Director of Communications position was presented for discussion. Mailyn Jeffries explained the salary level history of the position. It was recommended by Human Resources to freeze this position and open a public information officer position at a lower grade. Commissioner Bengsch seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.
