Katie Towns-Health Department Assistant Director

Ms. Towns informed the Commission that flu cases are on the decline. This flu season has seen over 4237 cases of confirmed flu. Which is the highest flu season in recent history. There have been 18 flu fatalities in Greene County. Ms. Towns explained that there is a new shingles vaccine that will be a two shot cycle. The Health Department is working on finalizing Animal Control and are also in the process of hiring another assistant director. Kathryn Frazier PIO for Health department informed Commission about the flu page on the website. Ms. Frazier also informed the Commission that on 04/14 @ 10 am there will be a dedication to the Fulbright Walking Trail.

Samantha Foster- Assistant OEM Director

Ms. Foster informed the Commission that the application period for Logistic Specialist has closed and over the next 2 weeks they will conduct interviews to fill that position. National Weather Service is offering a class in Storm Spotting, over 24 people are signed up for the class from all over the area.

Zim Schwartz-E911

Ms. Schwartz handed the Commission E911's end of the year report with YTD totals for 2017. Zim offered to come to a huddle and explain what text to 911 is. 911 will be sending over a proclamation for the Commission to sign for National Emergency Operators Week. JR Russel updated the Commission on current house and senate bills that would affect 911.
