Bill Prince-Chief Juvenile Officer

Updated the Commission that as of today the legislation for 17 year olds to be considered Juveniles as not been passed. Mr. Prince informed the Commission that their office is seeking to add a new position of Data Analysis. Mr. Bill Prince asks that the Commission allows the position to be posted at a grade 14, Jeff Scott Budget Officer explained to the Commission what the starting pay of a grade 14 vs 13 would do to the overall budget. Harold Bengsch and Lincoln Hough both give Juvenile the go ahead to post the job at a grade 14. The Commissioners were reminded that on 05/10<sup>th</sup> the Juvenile Office will be having their family picnic and the Commission is invited.

Mailyn Jeffries -HR Director

Presented to the Commission the "Use of Personal Communications Devices for Business Purposes" handout. Ms. Jefferies explained the handout in detail. Cell phone stipends were explained and what the new proposed plan is to have 3 tiers in place for employee who receive stipends. It is unknown how many employees after the new policy goes into effect will need receive a stipend. Jeff Scott suggests a questionnaire be sent out that simply asks how often each employee that should receive a stipend uses their device. The Commission agreed that is a good idea and Ms. Jeffries will send out a questionnaire.
