

Greene County Commission Briefing

Present: Bob Cirtin, Harold Bengsch, Lincoln Hough, Jeff Scott, Cindy Stein, Phil Corcoran, Sheriff Jim Arnott, Mailyn Jeffries, Rick Artman, Donna Barton, Rick Artman and Megan Applegate.

Discussion on payout of sick leave for Deputy Roberts ensued. Roberts died in the line of duty in September, and his family received half of his sick pay approx. \$900 however the other half which is approx. \$900 was discussed for payout. The current policy states that if a current employee has been employed at least 10 years with the county upon retirement or death they are able to collect half of their sick leave. Commissioner Bengsch suggest that the policy be changed to include caveats for when an employee dies on the clock regardless of tenure they are given their full sick payout. Commissioner Hough also concurred with Bengsch that this would be a wise change. After further discussion Cirtin, Bengsch and Hough asked that Ms. Jeffries revise the policy and present it back to commission and other officer holders and department directors for review and approval.

HR Director Mailyn Jeffries reminded Commission hat today is the Employee Appreciation Day is today and begins at 11. Flu Shot Clinic will begin Thursday and Friday and a county wide email has been sent to all employees with times and location. NPR Conference will be held next week in Branson and will be Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.

Budget Officer Jeff Scott gave an update on the park tax issue. Scott has met with all municipalities who have been over paid. Republic was over paid approx. \$40, 000.0 and there is a plan for Scott, Coulter and Republics Attorney to discuss options, Scott and Coulter plan to meet with County Counselor before meeting with Republic. Walnut Grove was also over paid and was receptive to make a lump payment to rectify the error. Battlefield has requested a letter signed by the Commission explained the error and have it sent to the Mayor and Alderman. Hough asked if the idea of not having these municipalities pay back what they were over paid as it was Greene Counties error and have the issue corrected going forward. All option will be discussed at a later date. Scott reminded Commission that there is a Tax Oversight Committee board meeting today at 2 at the PSC.

Highway Director Rick Artman discussed an issue regarding sewer in the farm road 146 area.

With no other business the meeting was adjourned.
