OEM Director Larry Woods expressed concern for emergency services to respond to homes in the affected areas.

Highway Director Rick Artman contacted the fire chief of Willard, Fire Chief confirmed that the full size engines are able to travel through the flooded areas and has responded to a call in the area since the floods with no problems. If needed the fire engine could help transport out of the flood zone to an ambulance if an emergency arose.

Barnes explained that a rep. from his office will make a visit with a resident in the area.
