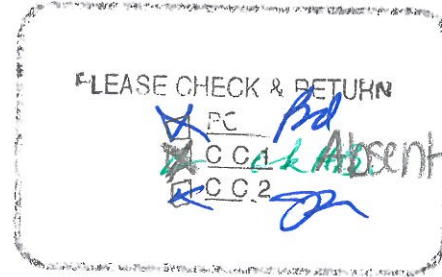

Informational Items: Resource Management: Director Kevin Barnes stated that the historic courthouse is currently having an issue with the electronic door latch but staff is working to fix the problem. Barnes explained that the old building permits will be moved to the operations center as they have optimal storage space available. Barnes expected to make an offer on a code compliance officer in the very near future.

Items for Consideration and Action by the Commission

(EX1) Inmate Housing Agreement, Webster County, Sheriff's Office: Major Royce Denny presented the agreement to the commission. He explained that Webster County will provide up to 50 beds to Greene County. Denny also explained the per diem rates are the same as all other housing agreement signed in the past. Commissioner John Russell moved to approve the inmate housing agreement with Webster County and to leave the vote open until Commissioner Harold Bengsch returns. Commissioner Bob Dixon seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Commissioner Harold Bengsch voted yes and signed the document on November 20 at 3:30 PM.
